

There are three children's healthcare programs from the Department of Social & Health Services (DSHS).

① **How many people are in the child's family?**

- Include parents and children under 19
- Include unborn child (pregnancy) as a family member

② **What is the child's family's monthly income (before taxes)?**

- Don't forget to include any **benefits** received from agencies like DSHS, SSI, L&I worker's compensation, unemployment, child support you receive.
- If you are **self-employed**, call 1-800-735-7040 for more information on the additional deductions you are allowed to take.
- Subtract any monthly work-related **child or adult care expenses** you pay.
- Subtract all monthly court ordered **child support payments** you pay for a child living outside the home.
- Do not count **food stamps** as income.
- **Subtract \$90** for each working adult in the household ("earned income credit").

③ **Compare to see if the child's family's monthly income is close to the limit.**
